



30:30 JAY KOKA STUDIO» It takes guts, talent and vision to leave a well-paying steady job and strike out on one's own into the uncertain world of fine art – especially when there's a growing family to support – but those qualities are what automotive fine artist Jay Koka (www.hemmings.com/magazine/hcc/2006/04/Jay-Koka/1281861.html) possesses in spades. Jay has commemorated three decades of his Jay Koka Studio with the autobiographical book, *30:30*, representing 30 years and 30 of his most important paintings. This Automotive Fine Arts Society member has collected some incredible pieces, including background information on each one and, where available, comments from the collectors who now own them, and his own biography is fascinating. The 98-page hardcover itself is a work of art, and a great overview of the creative evolution of one of the automotive world's most respected artists.
